TERMS AND CONDITIONS



This document sets out the terms and conditions governing the use and booking of Cornelian Bay Boat House Restaurant. Please read over these terms and conditions carefully and let us know if you have any questions

PAYMENT

Payment of the deposit is agreement to the following conditions:

To secure your reservation we require an advance deposit of \$250.00 to be paid within 14 days of making the initial booking. This deposit is only refundable if cancellation occurs eight weeks or more prior to the booking date. We request the balance of the account to be paid on or prior to the wedding day.

We do not accept Diners Club A surcharge of 3% will be added to accounts paid by American Express. This surcharge does not apply when other credit cards, cash or cheques are used.

MINIMUM ACCOUNT

Exclusive use of the restaurant on a Saturday evening requires a minimum account of \$6,500. This amount is negotiable for other days of the week and Saturday nights during the offpeak season ie May – August.

FINAL ATTENDANCE

Final numbers are required 48 hours prior to the function date, this is the minimum number we will charge for.

DAMAGES

The client will be financially responsible for any damage sustained at Cornelian Bay Boat House by the client or client’s guests.

RESPONSIBILITY

We do not accept any responsibility for the damage or loss of merchandise or personal property left on the premise during or after a function. We would appreciate gifts, flowers etc to be removed at the completion of the function or no later than 11:45am the following day.

CONSUMPTION

Cornelian Bay Boat House is a fully licensed restaurant all food and alcohol consumed on the premises must be supplied by us. With the exception of wedding cakes. Cornelian Bay Boat House practices responsible service of alcohol.
